Course Description

The concept of German literature developing in relation to cultures around the world is explored in the novels, travel writing, and short stories from the 18th century to the present. German literary traditions and topics are contrasted with how culture is defined from the outside by German travel writers and exiles. The evolution of literary forms in response to changes in culture is explored as well as the process of popularizing literature in film productions.
