HOWARD J. BAUMGARTEL PEACE AND JUSTICE AWARD
For thesis or dissertation research

The Howard J. Baumgartel Peace and Justice Award is an annual award to support a graduate student in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences or the School of Business for thesis or dissertation research whose interests, achievements, and talents are in the peace and justice field. The award amount is \$2500.00 and will be disbursed in May of 2007.

Examples of appropriate interests for this award are social scientific study of, or application of social scientific knowledge to: conflict resolution, social action, human problems in the world of work, race and ethnic relations, and Third World Development.

- I. Eligibility: Any Master's or Ph.D. student engaged in thesis or dissertation research during the summer of 2007 or during the 2007-2008 academic year. The student must be enrolled in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences or the School of Business at the University of Kansas.

- II. The Supporting Documents
 - A. An up-to-date vita

 - B. A one page description of the thesis or dissertation topic.
 - Describe the research proposal in language to be understood by the greater academic community.
 - State how the monetary award will help to fund the applicant's research.

 - C. A letter of support from the applicant's advisor or department chair.

- III. Deadline and Application Procedure

Self-nominations or nominations from faculty are acceptable.

Deadline: Must be received in the College Office by February 19, 5:00 p.m.
