Graduation Steps

1. Complete paperwork for your MAJOR and/or MINOR
Make an appointment with your major/minor advisor. For all majors and minors (except BA and BGS Economics and Psychology), have a [Major Certification Sheet \(MCS\)](#) and/or a [Minor Certification Sheet \(MIN\)](#) completed and signed by your major/minor faculty advisor.
*You should have your final graduation advising appointment before the first day of fall classes.
2. Submit your Major and/or Minor Certification Sheets to College Student Academic Services, 109 Strong Hall.
3. **Apply for Graduation on Enroll & Pay by JULY 8, 2011 to receive a priority degree audit**, or by October 7, 2011 if you plan to attend the December recognition ceremony (for further information, see commencement information below).

The *final* deadline to apply for graduation for Fall 2011 is **November 1, 2011**. If your academic plans change after you file your MCS and Apply for Graduation on Enroll & Pay, please notify College Student Academic Services, 109 Strong Hall.

*Please apply for graduation for the term you plan to *FINISH* your degree requirements.

Do any of the following apply to you? You are responsible for meeting the following deadlines:

<p>-Study Abroad Paperwork -Petitions</p>	<p>If you have completed a study abroad program, it is beneficial for you to complete the necessary paperwork so your coursework posts before your last semester. You should not wait to petition a general education requirement in your last semester. Waiting to take action with either of these may delay your graduation.</p>
<p>Independent Study</p>	<p>If you are completing any KUCE coursework for your degree, the final exam should be taken by the deadline to guarantee the grade is on your record in time for fall graduation.</p>
<p>Incomplete Grades</p>	<p>If you are finishing an incomplete to fulfill graduation requirements, your instructor must submit your grade to the Office of the University Registrar. <i>*Any remaining Incompletes on your academic record will be calculated as an "F". As of Fall '09, Incomplete grades will be converted to an "F" one year after the Incomplete is assigned or upon graduation. If either causes your KU GPA or Major Junior/Senior GPA to drop below a 2.0, your degree will not be granted.</i></p>
<p>Transfer Credit</p>	<p>If you are taking courses at another institution to complete graduation requirements, your <u>official transcript</u> must be received by the Office of Admissions & Scholarships, 1502 Iowa Street, Lawrence, KS 66045 <i>*Be aware that there are residency requirements related to the last year of your degree, your major work and total junior/senior hours completed for your KU degree; please make sure you completely understand these requirements* *It is YOUR responsibility to provide official transcripts. Transcripts received after the deadline will delay the granting of your degree.</i></p>

Honors Intent Forms	If you are pursuing departmental honors, complete an Honors Intent Form. Have this form signed by your honors advisor. Submit the form to College Student Academic Services, 109 Strong Hall (If you do not meet the deadline, you will not be listed in the spring commencement program)

Graduation Hold: Every semester once you reach 90 hours you will receive a hold in order to assess your progress towards a degree.

Commencement: The CLAS Fall 2011 graduation ceremony will be **December 11, 2011** at the Lied Center. You will receive an invitation in October.

Diploma: Make a **Diploma Delivery Request** on Enroll & Pay after you Apply for Graduation. You may request to pick up your diploma at the Student Records Center, 151 Strong Hall (bring a picture ID) or you may request to have your diploma mailed to you.
