

MOST COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT APPLYING

The following are questions (with answers) that are "most commonly asked" by individuals who are applying & reapplying for admission into our doctoral program.

CAN I GET JUST A MASTER'S DEGREE? No. The Clinical Child Psychology Program admits students to the program with the expectation of continuing graduate study through the Ph.D. Students earn an MA enroute to the Ph.D., but there is no terminal master's degree program in our program.

DO I NEED TO FILL OUT A NEW APPLICATION OR CAN YOU REACTIVATE MY OLD FILE IF I AM REAPPLYING? A new graduate school application, along with another application fee, will need to be filled out for admission. Application materials are kept on file for 1 year; after that time they will be destroyed. You may inform us as to what materials you would like to use again.

DO I NEED TO PAY ANOTHER APPLICATION FEE EACH TIME I APPLY? The application fee is waived very rarely and only under special circumstances.

DO I NEED TO RETAKE THE GRE OR HAVE MY OLD SCORES RESENT? GRE scores are valid for five years from the test date. You can use the GRE scores previously sent if they are **valid and original** scores.

DO I NEED TO RESEND TRANSCRIPTS? If no further changes have been made to transcripts already on file, we can use those already sent. Please be advised, however, it is the responsibility of the applicant to make sure all transcripts have been received and contain the most recent grades available.

DO I NEED TO HAVE NEW RECOMMENDATION LETTERS SENT? Letters that have already been sent can be used again providing they have been written recently.
