

Breakout Sessions

Children with Special Needs - This session will focus on available resources and support for families that include a child with a disability. Individual Family Service Plans (IFSPs) and Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) will be explained with an emphasis on parents' rights and responsibilities within the process.. This session is translated into Spanish.

Anger Behavior Management - This workshop will focus on helping teens and families to prevent outbursts of anger and learn positive ways to communicate about anger. This session is translated into Spanish.

Partnering in the Land of Oz - This session will take a look at effective practitioner/parent partnerships in parent leadership involvement.

Immigration Issues - This workshop will take a look at updates and current proposals to modify immigration laws. This session is spoken in Spanish and translated into English.

The Yellow Brick Road to Parent Leadership and Advocacy - Parents will gain insight into ways they can begin to step up into a "leadership role" and advocate in their community for programs and services which will benefit all families and children.

Early Childhood and YOU - This presentation will cover an introduction of the Kansas Coalition for School Readiness. It explains how you can get involved, and what you can do to help.

Strengthening Families - This workshop will provide an overview of the Strengthening Families approach and Protective Factors that support and strengthen all families.

It Sounds So Easy, But It's So Hard to Do: Building and Maintaining Positive Nurturing Relationships While Living with Difficult Circumstances - This session will discuss "What makes a supportive and helpful parent child relationship?" This workshop will be spoken in Spanish and translated into English.

Mexican Consulate - Parents will gain knowledge into remittance programs, 3 for 1 programs, hometown clubs and their relationship with community origin development projects. This session is spoken in Spanish and translated into English.
