- c) A cassette recording in French, at least ten minutes in length, describing your background, training, interests, experiences, etc. (Applicants whose native language is French should disregard this requirement.)

7. See that recommendation forms (or letters of recommendation) are submitted by three individuals who can evaluate your previous academic work, especially in French.

8. Domestic applicants should arrange to have an official copy of GRE scores sent to the department by the testing service.

9. If your native language is not English, please be sure that you fill out a Foreign Student application and that you refer to the Graduate Program brochure for an explanation of the University's requirements for proficiency in English.

10. The program requires a \$35 processing fee for all applications. Please make checks payable to The University of Kansas.
