Supportive Educational Services is a federally funded [TRiO Program](#) known nationally as Student Support Services. Our goal is to assist eligible students to obtain their undergraduate degrees. All of our services are free and aimed at helping our participants be successful at The University of Kansas. You **MUST** [apply](#) and be accepted to the program.



Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen or a permanent resident
- Be accepted for enrollment or currently enrolled at KU
- Demonstrate academic need
- Demonstrate high motivation to successfully complete your coursework

You must also meet any one of the following criteria:

- A first-generation college student (neither of your parents has received a four-year college bachelor's degree)
- Low-income according to federal guidelines
- Have a documented disability through [Disability Resources](#)

Services offered:

- Tutoring: Individual peer tutoring and [Math Drop-In Lab](#)
- Professional Mentoring: one-on-one meetings with SES coordinators, goal setting, advocacy
- Academic Advising and Course Selection: Our coordinators are adjunct advisors for the [UAC](#)
- Career Counseling: Explore majors and careers, referrals to the University Career Center
- Financial Aid Counseling and Literacy: Assistance with FASFA, verification, appeals, scholarship applications, budgeting, referrals
- Graduate School Preparation: Assistance with
