New Faculty General Research Fund (NFGRF)

Research is a highly valued mission of the University of Kansas Office of Research endeavors to assist KU Lawrence campus faculty in their efforts to secure funding for their individual or group research programs. The New Faculty General Research Fund Program (NFGRF) has been designed to help new tenure-track faculty members accelerate their individual scholarship and assist in building a sustainable research program. It is our hope that new faculty members will view this program as an excellent opportunity to jump-start their research efforts soon after their arrival on campus.

Full details of the NFGRF program are outlined below. A crucial aspect to the success of this program is mentoring. Each new faculty member who receives funding from this program should work with his/her department chair or dean to select a faculty mentor. The mentor will guide the new faculty member in developing his/her research program and assist in planning and preparing his/her proposal. Ideally, mentors will be members of the faculty in a related research area with experience and success in obtaining external funding and support.

Awards are managed by KU Research. The NFGRF program is a State of Kansas-funded award, rather than a corporate/federal grant and, as such, expenditures must follow state guidelines. Funds may be used for supplies, equipment, travel or summer salary and fringe benefits for the faculty member and salary for graduate and undergraduate student assistants. It is not necessary or appropriate to routinely apply for the maximum award size; make a case for what you need. Expenditures must comply with university and state rules and procedures.

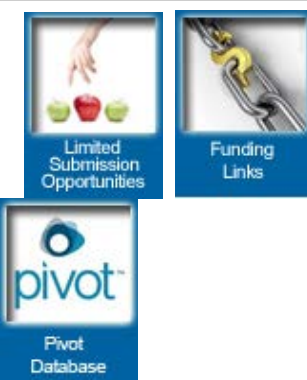
