## Supplemental Instruction

Supplemental Instruction (SI) consists of weekly peer facilitated study sessions for students to review course material outside of the classroom. It's a chance for students to meet others in the class, compare notes, discuss important concepts, and review material in order to enhance class performance.

During each session, SI Leaders provide study strategies for note taking, organization, and test preparation. They lead a discussion over lecture material and notes in order to review and better prepare students for success in the class.

SI Leaders are recommended by faculty teaching the courses and the SI Leaders attend trainings. To prepare for weekly sessions, the SI Leaders attend all class meetings, take notes, read and complete all assigned materials, and communicate with the respective professor and SI Supervisor.
