Reservation and Payment

Reserve your place for "YOU at KU" by mailing or faxing the attached reservation form, OR submit your reservation online at <http://www2.ku.edu/~issfacts/prospective/orientation/>.

Pay by **Friday, July 16** and receive a **\$10 Early-Pay Bonus Discount**. You can pay online when you sign up, or with U.S. or international money order, cashier's check (with an American bank address on it), or a personal check from an American bank, made payable in U.S. dollars to "The University of Kansas" if you mail your reservation. There is a 6% service fee added for online payment. Sorry, no refunds if you decide not to attend.

Arrival and Registration

Registration for "YOU at KU" is **12:30-5:30 p.m., Sunday, August 8 at McCollum Hall** (1800 Engel Road). If you arrive late, register at the International Student & Scholar Services Office, Room 2 Strong Hall, Mon-Fri, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

At registration you will receive your name tag, schedule and welcome packet. If you did not prepay (Option #2 only!), you will also pay your reservation fee in the form of cash, U.S. or international money order, cashier's check (with an American bank address on it), or a personal check from an American bank. See the "Pre-Arrival Guide" for suggestions on transportation from the Kansas City airport to Lawrence.

Housing

Official housing for "YOU at KU" participants will be in McCollum Hall, an on-campus residence hall at 1800 Engel Road. Accommodations are double occupancy rooms with a roommate and a community bathroom. Housing cost is additional and covers room rent for the nights August 8-12. This fee also includes use of towels, bed sheets, pillow with case and blanket as well as 5 breakfasts. **Orientation Housing at McCollum will not be guaranteed if we do not receive your payment by August 1!** If you have a fall contract for KU housing and live in the orientation housing, the orientation staff will help you move into your fall assignment at the end of Orientation week. Additional nightly fees will apply.

If you have contracted to stay in Stouffer Place apartments, please refer to your contract to see when you can move in.

You may also choose to make your own housing arrangements some place else. However, "YOU at KU" transportation is not provided for locations other than McCollum Hall. See the "Pre-Arrival Guide" for suggestions on motel options.
