Yiddle with His Fiddle (*Yidl mitn Fidl*)

Don't miss the chance to see *Yidl*, the most commercially successful musical in the history of the Yiddish cinema! This is the classic folk comedy about Arye and his daughter Itke (starring Molly Picon), who decide to become traveling klezmer musicians. Because her father is concerned about the misfortunes that can befall a young woman "out in the world," Itke disguises herself as a young man and calls herself Yidl. The two join together with "another" father-son duo for music, comedy and romance. This film was shot on location in Kasimierz, Poland, with local shtetl inhabitants as extras. Lyrics to the songs were written by the wonderful Yiddish poet Itzik Manger.
