

# Fall conferences draw big numbers

The three Kansas Scholastic Press Association sponsored fall conferences drew more than 1,500 students from across the state the week of September 22.

The first fall conference hosted by the University of Kansas drew 55 northeast Kansas schools and 961 students.

The second fall conference at Kansas State University on Tuesday drew 23 schools and 327 students. The final conference Wednesday at Fort Hays State University drew 15 schools and 272 students.

The total number of schools participating was 93 with 1,590 students from across the state in attendance at one of the three conferences.
