ALL-KANSAS YEARBOOK CRITIQUE

Deadline Oct. 3

Take hold of the opportunity to have your publication critiqued by one of the nation's best yearbook clinicians.

Submit your 2007 yearbook to KSPA along with a check for \$55. The entry form can be obtained from KSPA web site if you did not receive one with the initial fall conference mailing.

One judge will evaluate all books within each enrollment classification. Learn what makes a strong and effective yearbook by being one of the 80 schools who will typically submit their annual publication for evaluation.

The Kansas Scholastic Press Association will sponsor its seventh annual Fall Journalism Conference Wednesday, Sept. 24, 2008 at Fort Hays State University. This conference will provide student journalists and their advisers with new concepts to enliven their 2008-2009 publications. Sessions are being planned to include something for everyone.

More than 30 one-hour sessions are on the schedule. A complete conference schedule will be posted at <www.fhsu.edu/communication/KSPAFall08> Special sessions will be presented for advisers. Both advanced and beginning students will find sessions suited for them. The cost for the one-day session will be \$13 per person for KSPA members and \$15 for non-KSPA members. Please note the fee does not include lunch. Students and advisers will be on their own for lunch; however, meal service may be obtained in the FHSU Memorial Union food court. Doughnuts and juice will be available free of charge for students and advisers at registration.

The registration deadline for the fall conference is Monday, Sept. 15, 2008. Registrations faxed or postmarked after Sept. 15 cannot be accepted. Advisers may substitute students as long as the number in attendance is not greater than the number pre-registered. Checks should accompany the pre-registration form. With your acknowledgment letter you will receive a campus map and a Hays motel listing should you need overnight accommodations. School registration materials may be picked up at 8 a.m. in the registration area of the FHSU Memorial Union. The opening session will begin at 9 a.m.

Parking is available on campus near the Memorial Union. Parking instructions will be sent with your registration confirmation.

Maps of the FHSU Memorial Union will be included with your program. We anticipate adequate seating for all who would like to attend.
