Aaron Manfull is the media adviser at Francis Howell North High School in St. Charles, MO. He taught for three years in Iowa and is in his eighth year of advising at FHN. There he advises the school's monthly newsmagazine, the yearbook, the weekly video podcast and the daily online edition FHNtoday.com. Manfull is a frequent and popular conference and convention speaker at both state and national events.

The Kansas Scholastic Press Association will sponsor its 27th annual Fall Journalism Conference Tuesday, Sept. 23, 2008 at Kansas State University. Sessions are being planned to include something for everyone.

More than 60 one-hour sessions are on the schedule. Special sessions will be presented for advisers. Both advanced and beginning students will find sessions suited for them. The cost for the one-day session will be \$13 per person for KSPA members and \$15 for non-KSPA members. Please note the fee this year does not include lunch. Students and advisers will be on their own for lunch; however, meal service may be obtained in the K-State Student Union.

The registration deadline for the fall conference is Tuesday, Sept. 16, 2008. Registrations faxed or postmarked after Sept. 16 cannot be accepted. Advisers may substitute students as long as the number in attendance is not greater than the number pre-registered. Checks should accompany the pre-registration form. With your acknowledgment letter you will receive a campus map for your convenience. We will also provide a Manhattan motel listing should you need overnight accommodations. Registration materials may be picked up on the lower level of the Student Union in front of the Forum Theater. The opening session will be at 9 a.m.

Parking on college campuses is always difficult. Buses may unload in the drop-off zone on the west side of the student Union and then go to the parking lot on the east side of the football stadium. Those delegates driving cars may reserve a parking spot in D1, West Parking Lot, for the day for \$3. Buses are \$5. If you would like a parking reservation, please mark the appropriate spot on the registration form and return with your payment on Sept. 18.

The conference will be in Kedzie Hall and in the K-State Union. Maps for these locations will be provided in your packets.
