Aggravated Indecent Solicitation of a Child

Incident Summary:

On September 19, 2007 between the hours of 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. an Asian male approached a child playing in the area of Stouffer Place. The suspect asked the child his name and when he didn't answer him, the suspect asked the child if he would come to his car and play with him. The child ran away, and the suspect then left the area in his car.

Suspect Information: Asian male wearing a blue shirt and blue or gray pants.

Safety Tips:

- **Teach your child about strangers. Tell him or her to never talk, take candy, or go with a stranger without your consent.**
- **Make sure your child knows never to get into a stranger's car.**
- **Tell your child that if approached by a stranger, run and scream.**
- **If you're home alone after school, check in with a parent or neighbor as soon as you walk in the door.**
- **If you see anyone doing something that makes you uneasy or you think isn't right like a stranger hanging around the school playground, tell your parents, a teacher, or another trusted adult.**
- **Report any suspicious activity to the KU Public Safety Office.**
