Aggravated Burglary

Incident Summary:

On September 23, 2007 between 1a.m. and 2 p.m. an unknown person entered an unsecured room in Oliver Hall while the resident was sleeping and removed the resident's laptop computer.

Safety Tips:

- **Lock** your doors when you are home and while you are away.
- Report any suspicious activity to the KU Public Safety Office.
- Record the serial numbers of valuable items and keep the information in a safe place.
- Engrave valuable property, electric engravers can be checked out at the KU Public Safety Office.
- If you are at home when a burglar enters your residence, do not confront them. Try to get out of the home or lock yourself inside a room then call the police. Material possessions can be replaced.
