Level II: Advanced Roads Scholar: Supervisory Skills Program

To develop supervisory skills for persons engaged in public works maintenance and construction activities.

Level III: Master Roads Scholar: Executive Development Program

To enhance management and administrative skills for those who are appointed or aspire to be appointed as a county highway administrator, county or city engineer, or public works director.
