**Level I: Roads Scholar: Technical Skills Program**  
To enhance the knowledge of general public works maintenance and construction methods, safety practices, and local government organization as it applies to the direct delivery of quality public service.

**Level II: Advanced Roads Scholar: Supervisory Skills Program**  
To develop supervisory skills for persons engaged in public works maintenance and construction activities.

**Level III: Master Roads Scholar: Executive Development Program**  
To enhance management and administrative skills for those who are appointed or aspire to be appointed as a county highway administrator, county or city engineer, or public works director.
