## **GRADUATE TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS IN MUSIC THERAPY**

### Positions:

Several music therapy graduate teaching assistantships are anticipated. Forty percent time assistantships require sixteen hours of service per week.

Starting date: Mid-August.

### Qualifications:

Master's degree preferred; bachelor's required.

CBMT Board Certification required.

Clinical music therapy experience beyond internship; supervisory experience preferred.

Admission to the music education or music therapy graduate program.

Duties selected from the following, according to the individual's qualifications and division's needs:

Teaching in the undergraduate music therapy program.

Participate in team teaching activities with tenure-line faculty.

Supervise music therapy clinical practicum students; participate in administration of practicum program.

Supervise and teach in the psychology and acoustics of music laboratory.

Participate in on-going division research.

Participate in curriculum development and similar faculty activities.

Provide direct services to selected clients as a model for music therapy students.

### Benefits:

Anticipated salary approximately \$8000 for the academic year (40%).

Anticipated full tuition waiver.

Access to the division's research and instruction facilities.

Private music study at no additional charge.
