Students from Atchison County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **93 students** from Atchison County:

- 65 undergraduates
- 28 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Atchison County.

As of October 2007, \$177,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 36 Atchison County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$63,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$49,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$49,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$16,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Maur Hill-Mount Academy in Atchison – 31 students
- Atchison High School – 25 students
- Atchison County Community High School in Effingham – 10 students

Atchison County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **186** have attended **Benedictine College** in Atchison.
