

**Students from Bourbon County

Lawrence and Medical Center Campuses**

Students from Bourbon County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **48 students** from Bourbon County:

- 31 undergraduates
- 17 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Bourbon County, **39%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergrads overall.

KU supports students from Bourbon County.

As of October 2007, \$79,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 23 Bourbon County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$28,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$24,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$22,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 4,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Fort Scott High School – 36 students
- Uniontown High School – 4 students

Bourbon County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **245** have attended **Fort Scott Community College**.
