***Students from Butler County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **350 students** from Butler County:

- 298 undergraduates
- 52 graduate/first professional students

***KU supports students from Butler County.***

As of October 2007, \$571,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 135 Butler County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$235,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$162,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$139,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 35,000 in state scholarships and grants

***Where are they from?***

The primary feeder high schools in this county are

- Andover High School – 88 students
- Andover Central High School – 63 students
- Rose Hill High School – 42 students
- Augusta High School – 34 students
- El Dorado High School – 27 students

***Butler County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.***

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **772** have attended **Butler County Community College** in El Dorado.
