

**Students from Crawford County

Lawrence and Medical Center Campuses**

Students from Crawford County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **129 students** from Crawford County:

- 86 undergraduates
- 43 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Crawford County, **33%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Crawford County.

As of October 2007, \$294,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 69 Crawford County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$105,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 79,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 78,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 16,000 in state scholarships and grants
- \$ 16,000 in athletic grants

Where are they from?

- Pittsburg High School – 48 students
- St. Mary's-Colgan High School in Pittsburg – 21 students
- Girard High School – 13 students
- Northeast High School in Arma – 7 students
- Frontenac Junior-Senior High School – 5 students
- Southeast High School in Cherokee – 2 students

Crawford County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **307** have attended **Pittsburg State University**.
