Students from Decatur County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **16 students** from Decatur County:

- 11 undergraduates
- 5 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Decatur County, **36%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Decatur County.

As of October 2007, \$51,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to eight Decatur County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$39,500 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 7,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 3,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 1,000 in state scholarships and grants
