***Students from Dickinson County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **68 students** from Dickinson County:

- 50 undergraduates
- 18 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Dickinson County, **38%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

***KU supports students from Dickinson County.***

As of October 2007, \$144,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 35 Dickinson County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$70,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$33,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$29,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$12,000 in state scholarships and grants

- Other high schools – 2 students
