***Students from Doniphan County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **33 students** from Doniphan County:

- 27 undergraduates
- 6 graduate/first professional students

***KU supports students from Doniphan County.***

As of October 2007, \$85,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 20 Doniphan County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$31,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$24,500 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$22,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 7,500 in state scholarships and grants

***Where are they from?***

- Troy High School – 14 students
- Doniphan West High School in Highland – 4 students
- Wathena High School – 2 students
- Elwood High School – 1 student

***Doniphan County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.***

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **605** have attended **Highland Community College**.
