Students from Ellis County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **150 students** from Ellis County:

- 109 undergraduates
- 41 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Ellis County, **36%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Ellis County.

As of October 2007, \$367,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 79 Ellis County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$216,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 87,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 49,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 15,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Hays High School – 82 students
- Thomas More Prep-Marian High School in Hays – 28 students
- Ellis High School – 7 students
- Victoria High School – 5 students

Ellis County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **272** have attended **Ft. Hays State University** in Hays.
