

**Students from Ford County

Lawrence and Medical Center Campuses**

Students from Ford County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **138 students** from Ford County:

- 112 undergraduates
- 26 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Ford County, **31%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Ford County.

As of October 2007, \$308,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 65 Ford County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$103,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 89,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 80,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 25,000 in state scholarships and grants
- \$ 10,000 in athletic grants

Where are they from?

- Dodge City Senior High School – 99 students
- Bucklin High School – 11 students
- Spearville High School – 8 students

Ford County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **214** have attended:

- Dodge City Community College – 207 students
- St. Mary of the Plains College in Dodge City – 7 students
