Students from Jefferson County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **207 students** from Jefferson County:

- 171 undergraduates
- 36 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Jefferson County.

As of October 2007, \$437,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 94 Jefferson County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$157,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$122,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$118,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 40,000 in state scholarships and grants
