Students from Labette County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **72 students** from Labette County:

- 57 undergraduates
- 15 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Labette County.

As of October 2007, \$166,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 35 Labette County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$65,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$47,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$33,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$12,000 in athletic scholarships
- \$10,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Parsons Senior High School – 51 students
- Labette County High School in Altamont – 7 students
- Oswego High School – 2 students

Labette County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **130** have attended **Labette Community College** in Parsons.
