Students from Marion County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **42 students** from Marion County:

- 30 undergraduates
- 12 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Marion County.

As of October 2007, \$96,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 24 Marion County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$39,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$25,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$23,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 9,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Marion High School – 12 students
- Hillsboro High School – 11 students
- Peabody-Burns High School – 5 students
- Goessel High School – 4 students
- Centre High School in Lost Springs – 1 student

Marion County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **27** have attended **Tabor College** in Hillsboro.
