Students from Marshall County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **48 students** from Marshall County:

- 35 undergraduates
- 13 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Marshall County.

As of October 2007, \$125,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 27 Marshall County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$45,500 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$36,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$34,500 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 9,000 in state scholarships and grants
