***Students from McPherson County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **132 students** from McPherson County:

- 103 undergraduates
- 29 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from McPherson County, **34%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

***KU supports students from McPherson County.***

As of October 2007, \$268,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 62 McPherson County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$90,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$87,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$67,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$23,000 in state scholarships and grants

***Where are they from?***

- McPherson High School – 79 students
- Smoky Valley High School in Lindsborg – 14 students
- Inman High School – 10 students
- Moundridge High School – 4 students
- Canton-Galva High School – 2 students

***McPherson County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.***

Of the Fall 2007 KU students,

- **38** have attended **Bethany College** in Lindsborg.
- **14** have attended **Central Christian College** in McPherson.
- **12** have attended **McPherson College**.
