***Students from Meade County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **16 students** from Meade County:

- 12 undergraduates
- 4 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Meade County, **36%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergrads overall.

***KU supports students from Meade County.***

As of October 2007, \$17,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to Meade County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$10,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 4,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 1,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 1,000 in state scholarships and grants
