

**Students from Mitchell County

Students from Mitchell County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **42 students** from Mitchell County:

- 27 undergraduates
- 15 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Mitchell County, **42%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Mitchell County.

As of October 2007, \$94,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 22 Mitchell County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$31,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$29,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$28,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 6,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Beloit Junior-Senior High School – 25 students
- Saint Johns School in Beloit – 6 students
- Waconda East High School in Cawker City – 1 student
- Tipton High School – 1 student

Mitchell County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **1** has attended **North Central Kansas Technical College** in Beloit.
