Students from Montgomery County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **136 students** from Montgomery County:

- 116 undergraduates
- 20 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Montgomery County.

As of October 2007, \$330,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 66 Montgomery County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$115,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 98,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 93,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 24,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Independence Senior High School – 76 students
- Field Kindley Memorial High School in Coffeyville – 36 students
- Caney Valley High School – 7 students
- Cherryvale Senior High School – 3 students

Montgomery County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students,

- 144 had attended Independence Community College.
- 83 had attended Coffeyville Community College.
