Students from Nemaha County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **91 students** from Nemaha County:

- 74 undergraduates
- 17 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Nemaha County.

As of October 2007, \$302,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 60 Nemaha County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$117,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 94,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 54,500 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 36,500 in state scholarships and grants
