

**Students from Neosho County

Students from Neosho County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **76 students** from Neosho County:

- 48 undergraduates
- 28 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Neosho County, **33%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Neosho County.

As of October 2007, \$116,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 33 Neosho County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$46,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$28,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$27,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$15,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Chanute Senior High School – 42 students
- Erie High School – 12 students
- Thayer Attendance Center – 4 students
- Saint Paul High School – 2 students
- Chanute Christian Academy – 1 student

Neosho County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **849** have attended **Neosho County Community College** in Chanute.
