***Students from Rice County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **25 students** from Rice County:

- 15 undergraduates
- 10 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Rice County, **60%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

***KU supports students from Rice County.***

As of October 2007, \$48,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 13 Rice County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$16,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$15,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$15,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 2,000 in state scholarships and grants

***Where are they from?***

- Lyons High School – 8 students
- Sterling High School – 7 students
- Quivira Heights High School in Bushton – 3 students
- Chase High School – 2 students
- Little River High School – 2 students

***Rice County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.***

Of the Fall 2007 KU students, **23** have attended **Sterling College** in Sterling.
