Students from Rooks County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **23 students** from Rooks County:

- 19 undergraduates
- 4 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Rooks County, **42%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Rooks County.

As of October 2007, \$79,500 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 13 Rooks County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$64,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 7,500 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 7,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 1,000 in state scholarships and grants
