Lawrence and Medical Center Campuses**

Students from Saline County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **281 students** from Saline County:

- 235 undergraduates
- 46 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Saline County, **31%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the **27%** average of Lawrence campus undergraduates overall.

KU supports students from Saline County.

As of October 2007, \$642,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 137 Saline County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$229,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$168,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$157,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 47,000 in athletic grants
- \$ 41,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Salina High School Central – 113 students
- Salina High School South – 82 students
- Sacred Heart Junior-Senior High School in Salina – 33 students
- Southeast Saline Senior High School in Gypsum – 12 students
- Ell-Saline High School in Brookville – 7 students
- Other high schools – 3 students

Saline County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.

Of the Fall 2007 KU students,

- **79** have attended **Kansas Wesleyan University**.
- **16** have attended **Kansas State University Salina**.
- **12** have attended **Brown Mackie College**.
- **4** have attended **Marymount College**.
