Students from Sherman County make an important contribution to KU.

In Fall 2007, KU has **20 students** from Sherman County:

- 11 undergraduates
- 9 graduate/first professional students

KU supports students from Sherman County.

As of October 2007, \$60,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to Sherman County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$40,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$13,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 5,500 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$ 1,000 in state scholarships and grants

Where are they from?

- Goodland High School – 17 students

Sherman County postsecondary institutions contribute as well.
