***Students from Woodson County make an important contribution to KU.***

In Fall 2007, KU has **15 students** from Woodson County:

- 11 undergraduates
- 4 graduate/first professional students

Of the Lawrence campus undergraduate students from Woodson County, **37%** have ACT scores 27 or above compared to the 27% average of Lawrence campus undergrads overall.

***KU supports students from Woodson County.***

As of October 2007, \$47,000 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 9 Woodson County students for FY 2008. Included within this total:

- \$24,000 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$12,000 in institutional scholarships
- \$ 7,000 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$ 4,000 in state scholarships and grants
