**Students from Harvey County make an important contribution to KU.**

In Fall 2008, KU has 150 students from Harvey County:

- 122 undergraduates
- 28 graduate/first professional students

**KU supports students from Harvey County.**

As of October 9, 2008, \$352,012 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 66 Harvey County students for FY 2009. Included within this total:

- \$95,108 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$76,505 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$117,403 in institutional scholarships
- \$25,000 in state scholarships and grants
- \$37,996 in athletic grants
