**Students from Dickinson County make an important contribution to KU.**

In Fall 2009, KU has 75 students from Dickinson County:

- 62 undergraduates
- 13 graduate/first professional students

**KU supports students from Dickinson County.**

As of October 9, 2009, \$195,885 in federal, state, and institutional grants and scholarships have been awarded on the Lawrence and Medical Center campuses to 39 Dickinson County students for FY 2010. Included within this total:

- \$61,101 in Pell and other federal grants
- \$41,209 in KU Tuition and other institutional grants
- \$69,307 in institutional scholarships
- \$11,000 in state scholarships and grants
- \$13,268 in athletic grants
