The primary agenda item for this Friday's meeting is a discussion of selected aspects of the Self-study Report for North Central Accreditation. On behalf of Barbara Romzek, the chair of the NCA Steering Committee, attached are five pieces of the report that we would like for you to print and review prior to the meeting on Friday.

The five sections attached include:

- Future directions (10 pages)
- Significant changes from 1994 to 2004 (13 pages)
- Criterion 1: Mission and Integrity (18 pages)
- Criterion 2: Preparing for the Future (34 pages)
- Responses to 1994 Concerns (19 pages)

The first four of these sections provide a broad overview of the University and will provide the context for the remaining three criteria to be discussed at the next meeting of CPG.
