** Accreditation was granted for two years rather than the customary six years. A site visit team from ACPE will visit the School on March 3-4, 2010. The School was granted continuous accreditation in 2008 with a focused site visit in 2010 to address concerns related to partial compliance on 6 of the 30 standards. ACPE's concerns include finalizing a comprehensive assessment plan, full implementation of the introductory pharmacy practice experiential (IPPE) program, progress in hiring in Pharmacy Practice faculty, and an upgrade of physical facilities to provide for modern teaching activities. Significant improvement has been made on all of the outstanding issues and we will receive feedback from a self-report in April 2009 to check our progress.
