

Enroll and Pay Common Enrollment Errors

Error Message	What it Means
<p>Permission to enroll in this class is required. The class falls outside your career of study. Choose another class.</p>	<p>As a reminder, there are six careers in Enroll and Pay (Undergraduate, Undergraduate KUMC, Graduate, Graduate KUMC, Law, Medicine). Some classes are restricted to majors within those careers. If you desire to take a class outside your career and you receive this error message, you will need to get permission (specifically, a permission number) from the instructor or department offering the course.</p>
<p>Class ##### is full. Click Fix Errors to return to step 1.</p>	<p>You have attempted to enroll in a class that is full. The message also occurs when you are using the Swap function. You have attempted to swap a class in which you're enrolled for a class that's full. Choose another section/class, or seek permission to add the closed course.</p>
<p>You cannot add this class due to a time conflict with class #####. Select another class.</p>	<p>The system does not allow enrollment online in classes that have a time conflict. You may choose another time, or, in order to complete enrollment for courses with a time conflict, contact the Registrar's Office on your campus.</p>
<p>Unable to add this class - term maximum exceeded. Adding this class would exceed the maximum number of units or courses allowed for this term.</p>	<p>The system does not allow you to enroll in more units (credit hours) than the maximum allowed for your School. In order to enroll in any hours over the maximum, contact the Registrar's Office on your campus for more information.</p>
<p>You cannot drop this class. Dropping this class would put you below the minimum required units. Please contact the Registrar's Office on your campus to withdraw from the University.</p>	<p>The system will NOT permit you to drop all of your classes.</p>
<p>You have already taken this class. You have now exceeded the repeatable limit for this class. Verify that this class will apply toward your course of study.</p>	<p>You will be permitted to enroll in the class – the message is a warning that you are repeating a class and the appropriate repeat rules will be allowed.</p>

Error Message	What it Means
Unable to add this class - prerequisites have not been met. Check the class description for a list of enrollment requirements.	You do not meet the class requirements needed to enroll. To view the class requirements, go to the Class Detail and look in the Enrollment Information section under Enrollment Requirements. If you do not meet the requirements, choose another class, or get permissions to take the class.
The permission number entered is incorrect. Verify that the number you entered is correct or that the permission has not expired.	The permission number you used isn't valid. You might be trying to use it on the wrong class or it has already been used (permission numbers may only be used once). See the department that gave you the permission number to get this corrected.
You have a hold on your record. The hold on your record must be removed before this transaction can be processed.	You have an enrollment hold which you must clear before you can add or swap a class. Look on the right side of the Student Center for a list of your holds. You may click on the name of the hold to get more information about where to go to clear it.
