Audiology Clinic Courses (29 credit hours minimum)

Years 1 and 2:

AUD 843 Clinic Practicum. The first two semesters of AUD 843 are designed to provide the student with a variety of observation opportunities and clinical exposure. Direct patient contact will be minimal during these first two semesters. Students begin earning contact hours during the summer of the first year. When enrolled in AUD 843, 1 credit hour = ½ day per week in clinic during the fall and spring, 1 day per week in the summer.

Years 3 and 4:

AUD 944 Clinic Rotations. When enrolled in AUD 944, 1 credit hour = 1 day/week in clinic during fall and spring, 2 days/week in summer).

AUD 945 Clinic Externship. When enrolled in AUD 945, 40 hours per week in clinic = 9 credit hours during the fall and spring, 6 credit hours in the summer.

Independent Study (4 credit hours minimum)

AUD 846 (1-3/semester) – Leading to the completion of a research project by the middle of Year Three Spring.

Electives (6 credit hours minimum)

Additional Requirements

- Successful completion of the PRAXIS examination by the end of 3 full years of graduate study.
