

GENERAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS FOR ALL GRADUATE PROGRAMS

1. I completed the Personal Statement with my online application. Should I fill out another Personal Statement and mail it with my supplemental material?

ANSWER: The online Personal Statement will arrive with your online application. There is no need to send another copy. In addition, you have the option of uploading your resume or other documents to the online application instead of mailing them.

2. Should I mail my letters of recommendation or should the writers send the letters?

ANSWER: There are several choices for submitting letters of recommendation.

1) The online application offers the option for a secure email recommendation. 2) Or you may provide your recommenders with a pre-addressed envelope. 3) Or, you may provide your recommenders with the form and envelope to be sealed and returned to you. **No matter which option you choose, you must indicate whether you waive or do not waive access to the recommendation.**

3. My transcripts do not show my current semester grades. Do I want to send the transcript later and miss the deadline?

ANSWER: To avoid missing the deadline, it's usually safer to send the current transcript with the other material and provide the final semester grades in a separate mailing. The accuracy of your GPA will be verified when the final transcript arrives.

4. I have college credit from courses taken as a high school student and from several community colleges which transferred toward my bachelor's degree. Should I send all of those transcripts?

ANSWER: Applicants should submit one official transcript from all universities attended.

5. How do I apply for funding to support my graduate study? When will I know if I am receiving an offer of financial support from the Intercampus Program?

ANSWER: Check the www.ku.edu/~splh/ipcd website regularly for updates on funding opportunities and the contact person. Look under ADMISSIONS: Tuition and fees; Applying for Graduate Funding.

Funding is rarely identified until the applications have been reviewed and acceptance decisions are made. Updates on funding opportunities are sent via email to anyone who is accepted into the IPCD.
